With several pod puck readers malfunctioning, we were faced with the expense of replacing them. Randall took on the challenge of fixing them himself, and he began to take the readers apart and rebuild the inside with better and faster parts. The readers Randall refurbished work perfectly and are a great help in downloading and processing puck data faster. senior military and industry leaders, and international graduates from over 20 countries." Last month, the TPS formally opened the Satellite Operations Center (SOC) at Edwards Air Force base, and Nate was one of the individuals recognized for his work on the project.






YOUR FAMILY IS
