"Snake Oil Cures All" Healthcare Online Scams

Jim Lyon, IntegrITS FSO, shared the following information encouraging us to beware of healthcare online scams. Avast Threat Labs shared some prevalent health related scams that might impact your financial health more than your physical health.

- Much like other types of scams, these lure people in with a promise of some kind of miracle cure.
- They will use fake advertisements or articles on social media to lure people in.
- Once hooked, they will usually take your money directly...or transfer you to a "salesperson" to complete the order.
- The availability and use of AI has provided a greater (and faster) ability to leverage well-known individuals or institutions to garner unearned trust.

Helpful hints to spot these scams...

- Perform independent follow-up using online search for the product / solution. If you do not find anything else corroborating the article, or find a warning about it as a scam, then you should not purchase or 'buy in' to that offering.
- As convenient as it is to get your news from social media, we need to understand open forums are easy to fill with misinformation and lies. Verify your sources when it comes to "quick cures."
- These stories, like any other scam, make outlandish claims about the benefits of the drug/product in question. You may want to take the story with a grain of salt.
- As scamming gets more advanced with developments and open availability of AI and deepfakes, be aware that these kinds of scams are only going to get harder to spot. They may also start to come from fake versions of people you trust.


